Awards:	<p>Medals will be awarded in the division of Recurve, Compound, Barebow, Longbow, American Flatbow (AFB) and Traditional*. Archer categories will be: Open** and Women in each Senior, 50+, U21, U18, U16, U15, U14 and U12 age groups.</p> <p>Number of awards will be dependent on number of entrants in each category and at discretion of Targetcraft Archers CIO.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gold medal only awarded to 3 or less archers competing in a category per bowstyle • Gold, Silver and Bronze awarded to 4 or more archers competing in category per bowstyle <p>Presentation of the awards will be done after the shooting has been completed.</p>
